NOTES:	CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO THE VALIDATION OF A FOREIGN FLIGHT CREW LICENSE ISSUED BY AN ICAO CONTRACTING STATE
1.	The applicant must hold a valid foreign licence and current medical certificate before applying for a validation.
2.	A validation may be issued at the discretion of the Director for a period of 3 months.
3.	The applicant shall have passed the Vanuatu Air Law and Flight Rules and Procedures examination if the validation is to be used for the purpose of obtaining a Vanuatu Pilots Licence.
4.	The successful completion of the Biennial Flight Review is a pre-requisite for the holder of a validation permit, for Visiting Pilots intending to engage in Private Flying activities under Visual Flight Rules (VFR) within Vanuatu and a Pass in the Vanuatu Air Law Exam.
5.	The holder shall not fly as pilot in command to/from any airport unless, under the supervision of an authorised Instructor /Examiner. For Training Purpose only. The applicant must have held a valid type rating.
6.	The applicant shall submit with this application the following documentation; a) Valid Foreign Pilot's Licence with associated ratings. b) Valid Foreign Medical Certificate. c) Up to date personal Flying Log Book (s) detailing flying experience. d) Passport or Birth Certificate together with a Photo ID e) Police Clearance from the State that issued the pilot licence or (place of residence in the last 6 months.) f) Foreign pilots licence and medical will require verification with the issuing Authority. Receipt of verification may take up to a week with some Authorities.
7.	The applicant shall pay the applicable validation fee.
