



## Deregistration of Aircraft

### Notes on use of the CAAV 24047-05 Deregistration form

This form is used to request the Director within 14 days of becoming aware of the aircraft being destroyed, lost, stolen or withdrawn from use or is to be/has been exported, to remove the aircraft from the Vanuatu Register of Aircraft.

The owner/operator of the aircraft should fill out this form. If the owner/operator is not available (deceased), please complete form 24047-05A

This form is used to cancel the certificate of registration for a Vanuatu registered aircraft. The aircraft will be removed from the Vanuatu Register of Aircraft and any documents associated with the aircraft will be revoked.

The charges associated with the issue of the Export Airworthiness Certificate will be invoiced to the applicant.
